

Required Immunizations for Attendance

Iowa's Immunization Law requires a Certificate of Immunization be given to the school the child will attend prior to the first day of attendance. Students who do not provide a Certificate of Immunization, Provisional Certificate of Immunization or Certificate of Immunization Exemption to the school by the first day cannot attend.

- **If your child has health insurance that covers immunizations (including *hawk-i*),** your child needs to get shots at your medical provider. Bring your insurance card with you.
- **If your child is on Medicaid,** your child can get shots at your medical provider. Bring your insurance card with you.
- **If your child has no health insurance or is on Medishare,** your child can get shots at your medical provider. Bring your insurance card with you.
- **If your child has health insurance that does not cover any immunizations,** your child must get shots at Promise Community Health Center. Bring your insurance card with you.
- **If your child is American Indian or Alaskan Native,** your child can get shots at your medical provider.
- If you have questions regarding where your child can get shots or if there will be charges for the shots, please call your medical provider or Promise Community Health Center 712-722-1700 or Community Health Partners at 712-737-2971.

Please note that *most* area medical clinics now offer vaccines for children who are on Medicaid, who are uninsured, and who are American Indian or Alaskan Native. **A fee may be charged at your medical clinic, call ahead for details.** If you have questions regarding where your child can get vaccines, call your medical clinic, Promise Community Health Center, or Community Health Partners.

Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	4 doses
Polio	3 doses
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	1 dose
Hib (haemophilus influenzae type B)	3 doses
Hepatitis B	3 doses
Varicella	1 dose
Pneumococcal	4 doses

K-12

Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	5 doses
Polio	4 doses
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	2 doses
Hepatitis B	3 doses
Varicella	2 doses
Tetanus/Diphtheria/acellular Pertussis (Tdap)	1 dose *Required to enter 7th Grade or above
Meningococcal	1 dose *Required to enter 7th Grade or above 2 doses *Required to enter 12th Grade
