## **APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Motion was made by Van Den Top, seconded by Remmerde, to approve the agenda. Motion carried 5-0.

## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Motion was made by Van Den Top, seconded by Brosamle, to approve meeting minutes of May 9, 2022 and May 17, 2022. Motion carried 5-0.

## **CONSENT AGENDA**

Motion was made by Van Den Top, seconded by Brosamle, to approve the consent agenda including: May invoices and financial statements. Motion carried 5-0.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

The non-certified wage schedule was reviewed.

Motion was made by Kelderman, seconded by Brosamle, to approve utilizing Ahlers and Cooney as bond counsel. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion was made by Van Den Top, seconded by Remmerde, to approve resolution ordering an election on the issuance of \$25,000,000 general obligation school bonds. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion was made by Kelderman, seconded by Van Den Top, to approve 2022-2023 Human Resources sharing agreement with MOC-FV CSD and West Sioux CSD. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion was made by Kelderman, seconded by Remmerde, to approve the general fund committed balance of \$100,000 for the 2022-2023 school year for the purpose of any building repairs/improvements and any new purchases related to classroom equipment or furniture. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion was made by Kelderman, seconded by Van Den Top, to approve 2022-2023 meal prices: lunch - \$2.25 and breakfast – \$1.30. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion was made by Brosamle, seconded by Van Den Top, to approve 2022-2023 registration fees with no changes. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion was made by Brosamle, seconded by Remmerde, to approve 2022-2023 athletic fees with no changes. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion was made by Kelderman, seconded by Brosamle, to approve changes to the 500 series of board policies. Motion carried 5-0.

First reading of board policy 401.4 was held. Second reading will be on the July agenda.

Motion was made by Van Den Top, seconded by Brosamle, to approve the grievance procedure to be added to the employee handbook. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion was made by Kelderman, seconded by Van Den Top, to approve board policy 711.1. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion was made by Brosamle, seconded by Remmerde, to approve the following personnel changes:

Motion was made by Kelderman, seconded by Brosamle, to increase the Vocal Director stipend amount to \$4,896 for 2022-2023. Motion carried 5-0.

Principal Roder shared information on ISASP results, and Beable for ACT prep.
